FEB 8 — Surrendered Power

Readings: Isaiah 58:1-9a; Psalm 112:1-10; 1Corinthians 2:1-16; Matthew 5:13-20

1 LIFE engagement question

ONE aim: To see God at work in the relationships He has placed around us and join Him in His work. Praying for others in this and sharing stories builds our faith and gives us courage. Be patient and extend grace to one another as each one of you devotes yourselves to following Jesus' lead in your relationships. Everyone does not need to share each time you meet. Let God lead and do the work.

In what ways have you seen the Holy Spirit at work in you or your ONE?

1. How do you define power, and where has that definition been challenged or dismantled in your life?
2. What kinds of faith practices feel impressive but cost little—and what kinds feel costly but transformative?
3. Where are you tempted to rely on persuasion, image, or productivity instead of quiet faithfulness?
4. What does it mean to be salt or light without controlling outcomes or recognition?
5. How might surrender change the way you use whatever influence you already have?
