Surrendered Reach: Good neighbors are within reach

January 18th

1 LIFE weekly engagement question

ONE aim: To see God at work in the relationships He has placed around us and join Him in His work. Praying for others in this and sharing stories builds our faith and gives us courage. Be patient and extend grace to one another as each one of you devotes yourselves to following Jesus' lead in your relationships. Everyone does not need to share each time you meet. Let God lead and do the work.

This week's 1LIFE question: How have you been blessing and investing in your ONE(s) since we last met?

Scripture Readings: Isaiah 49:1-7; Psalm 40:1-11; 1 Corinthians 1:1-9; John 1:29-42

Discussion Questions:

- Who taught you (directly or indirectly) what it means to be a "good neighbor"?
- When have you seen God use a simple invitation in your life?
- Where do you currently feel most present in your daily life—and where do you feel disconnected?
- What does surrender look like in relationships rather than private spirituality?
- Where have you experienced belonging as a form of grace?
- How can presence itself be an act of faith?
- Where do you tend to overlook proximity in favor of distance or abstraction?
- In what ways do you confuse reaching out with fixing or convincing?
- Where might God be inviting you to show up more fully—not louder, but closer?
