Community Group Questions: Romans 12:1-2

1. Do you have a “workplace nemesis?” If so, what makes that person your “nemesis?”
2. What are some toxic tendencies you observe in your workplace? Do you find yourself contributing to the toxicity in your workplace?
3. Romans 12 is a deep passage. Paul calls followers of Jesus to offer their lives as living sacrifices to God through the renewing of our minds. What does it mean to “renew” our minds? How does that relate to humility?
4. Paul tells us that being humble means working according to our own gifting and trusting others are gifted in areas we are not. Does this kind of humility come easy to you? If not, what makes this kind of humility difficult? How might being a “control freak” be a symptom of pride in someone’s life?
5. Read Romans 12:10. What does this verse mean? In what ways might you have an agenda as you honor coworkers or friends/family?
6. When you think of peace, what comes to mind?
7. Peace is not passive. Peace is often painful. How can you be an advocate for peace in the workplace? What will peace require of you?
