

Signs of Life: Week 1

1 LIFE engagement question:

ONE aim: To see God at work in the relationships He has placed around us and join Him in His work. Praying for others in this and sharing stories builds our faith and gives us courage. Be patient and extend grace to one another as each one of you devotes yourselves to following Jesus' lead in your relationships. Everyone does not need to share each time you meet. Let God lead and do the work. ***What do you sense God is asking you to do next with your ONE?***

Discussion

Read: Water Into Wine (John 2:1–11)

Why do you think Jesus chose a wedding to do his first miraculous sign? Why do you think he chose to provide in this way rather than healing a medical condition or controlling the weather?

Jesus doesn't fix a crisis anyone outside the servants even knows about. What does that suggest about the way He works?

Where in your life do you mostly notice problems only after they become obvious — in yourself, relationships, or faith? What have you been ignoring the hardest lately?

This miracle wasn't necessary for survival — it restored joy and celebration. What does this reveal about what God cares about?

What's one place this coming week where you could look for quiet good instead of waiting for dramatic change?

Read: I am the Vine (John 15:1-8)

Like all good gardeners, God prunes branches that do not produce good fruit. Are there places in your life where you feel God is pruning?

Are there places in your life you feel God is pulling on a dead branch that you need to let go and surrender over to him?

Where are places God is calling you to focus on maintaining your good fruit? Are there places that are being neglected in your life?
