Read Hebrews 10:19-25

1. According to verses 19-22, what gives us confidence to approach God, and how is that different from how people often try to earn God's acceptance today?
2. Verse 23 says to "hold unswervingly to the hope we profess." What circumstances or challenges make it difficult to hold onto hope, and what helps you stay faithful?
3. What do you think it means to "consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds" (v. 24)? Can you share a time when someone encouraged you spiritually?
4. Verse 25 emphasizes not giving up meeting together. Why do you think gathering with other believers is so important, and what obstacles make it difficult in our culture today?
5. Looking at the entire passage, which invitation or command stands out to you most: draw near to God, hold fast to hope, or encourage one another? Why does that resonate with you right now?
