

May 3 Discussion Questions

1 LIFE Question

To see God at work in the relationships He has placed around us and join Him in His work. Praying for others in this and sharing stories builds our faith and gives us courage. Be patient and extend grace to one another as each one of you devotes yourselves to following Jesus' lead in your relationships. Everyone does not need to share each time you meet. Let God lead and do the work. What are some examples where you've felt promptings or nudgings of the Spirit with your ONE? What did you do?

Read: Luke 4:17-19; James 2:14-17, 26

1. In Luke 4:17–19, Jesus defines his mission in terms of justice, healing, and freedom. Where do you see those same needs in your current environment, and which one do you feel most drawn to respond to?
2. James 2 emphasizes that faith without action is dead. What's a practical example in your life where belief hasn't yet translated into action, and what's holding that gap in place?
3. Activist energy can come from conviction, pressure, guilt, anger, or compassion. What typically motivates you to act, and how can you tell if that motivation is aligned with the Spirit rather than urgency or expectation?
4. The series emphasizes that we don't "do" the Spirit—we create space for it to work. How do you balance taking action with staying spiritually grounded so your effort doesn't become burnout or self-reliance?
5. What is one small, specific action you can take this week that reflects your faith in motion, and how will you stay accountable to it?
