Small Group Time

Finish the Drawing

What You Need:

- Bible
- Paper
- Coloring supplies

What You Do:

During the Activity:

- Open your Bible and read Revelation 21:3-5 out loud to the kids.
- Share the following points:
- This is your future that's coming!
- God is going to move His home, heaven, down to earth, and we will live with Him forever!
- There will be no more sadness, crying, or pain in our forever home.
- God's going to fix everything that's broken to make it new!
- Give each kid a piece of paper and a marker.
- Say, "Our story today is about our forever home! There are a lot of things that we don't know about our forever home. But God did tell us some things about it in these verses! We do know that God is going to fix what's broken and make it new! 'New' starts with the letter N! On this piece of paper, draw the letter N."
- Say, "Now use your imagination and turn your letter N into something brand new!"
- Give the kids a few minutes to use their imagination.
- Let the kids who want to share show their new drawing to the group.
- Remember, our forever home is the new earth where God has fixed what is broken. And the New Jerusalem has come down too!"

What You Say:

"Wow, look at all these creative pictures! They look brand new! They don't even look like the letter N anymore!"

“Our true story from the Bible tells us that in our forever home, there will be no more crying or sadness. One of our Bible verses from today says, *He who was sitting on the throne said, ‘I am making everything new!’ (Revelation 21:5a NIV)*. How incredible is that? At the end of time, God’s rescue plan will be complete. He will make things exactly as He always wanted. God will live with people, just like in the Garden of Eden! And God will take away all the sadness, sickness, and death that entered the world after the fall. He will wipe away every tear from our eyes. Everything that’s hard and painful will be made right again. **[Bottom Line] God will make everything right in the end.**”

Pass the Verse

What You Need:

- Bibles
- Balloon
- Paper straws or chopsticks

What You Do:

Before the Activity:

- Inflate the balloon and tie a knot.

During the Activity:

- Give every kid a Bible and direct them to look up Galatians 6:9.
- Demonstrate how to look up the verse
- Read the verse aloud to the group.
- Review any words that might be unfamiliar to the kids.
- Invite the kids to set their Bibles aside.
- Give each kid a paper straw or chopstick.
- Explain that the kids are to pass the balloon all the way around the circle while saying the Memory Verse together, but they can only touch it with their straw or chopstick.
- If the balloon drops, start the verse over again. Try to make it all the way around the circle without dropping the balloon.

What You Say:

“That was tricky! You had to keep going even when the balloon was hard to control. Our Memory Verse is a great reminder to persevere and not give up. Jesus wanted His followers to know that we can remain faithful no matter what happens because He will be with us through hard times. And at the end of history as we know it, Jesus will return and fix everything that’s broken! We can keep doing good because we know that ***[Bottom Line]* God will make everything right in the end.**”

1. What do you think of when you think of Heaven?
2. What do you think will be the coolest thing in Heaven?
3. Who told John (the one who wrote the book of Revelation) about Heaven? Jesus told him.
4. Who will we live with in Heaven? Besides billions of other people and angels, God and Jesus.
5. Will we get hurt in Heaven? Nope
6. Can we get sick in Heaven? Nope
7. Can we die in Heaven? Nope
8. Will we get hungry or thirsty in Heaven? Nope
9. Will animals be scary in Heaven? Nope
10. Will we have homework in Heaven? Nope
