Small Group Time

Light Refraction

What You Need:

- CD or DVD
- Flashlight
- White wall or piece of paper

What You Do:

During the Activity:

- Dim the lights in your room.
- Ask the kids to gather around.
- Hold the CD/DVD and shine the flashlight onto its reflective surface.
- Tilt the CD/DVD until the light bounces off it and creates a rainbow on the wall or paper.
- Let the kids take turns holding the flashlight or the CD/DVD to make their own rainbows.

What You Say:

“Isn’t that beautiful? A plain old light shines on this disc and turns into all these amazing colors. Our Bible Story about our forever home says that God’s glory will be the light. It will be more beautiful than any rainbow we can imagine.

“Even when our world feels dark or sad sometimes, we can remember the light and beauty that God has promised. God is going to bring His home, heaven, down to earth. He is going to live with us forever! And the whole earth will be made new—God is going to fix everything that is broken. We can’t even imagine how amazing that will be—better than Christmas and your birthday and every holiday rolled into one because **[Bottom Line] God will make everything right in the end.**”

Pass the Verse

What You Need:

- Bibles
- Balloon
- Paper straws or chopsticks

What You Do:

Before the Activity:

- Inflate the balloon and tie a knot.

During the Activity:

- Give every kid a Bible and direct them to look up Galatians 6:9.
- Demonstrate how to look up the verse
- Read the verse aloud to the group.
- Review any words that might be unfamiliar to the kids.
- Invite the kids to set their Bibles aside.
- Give each kid a paper straw or chopstick.
- Explain that the kids are to pass the balloon all the way around the circle while saying the Memory Verse together, but they can only touch it with their straw or chopstick.
- If the balloon drops, start the verse over again. Try to make it all the way around the circle without dropping the balloon.

What You Say:

“That was tricky! You had to keep going even when the balloon was hard to control. Our Memory Verse is a great reminder to persevere and not give up. Jesus wanted His followers to know that we can remain faithful no matter what happens because He will be with us through hard times. And at the end of history as we know it, Jesus will return and fix everything that’s broken! We can keep doing good because we know that ***[Bottom Line]* God will make everything right in the end.**”
