1 LIFE engagement question

ONE aim: To see God at work in the relationships He has placed around us and join Him in His work. Praying for others in this and sharing stories builds our faith and gives us courage. Be patient and extend grace to one another as each one of you devotes yourselves to following Jesus' lead in your relationships. Everyone does not need to share each time you meet. Let God lead and do the work.

This week: What has God been showing you about himself, about you and/or about others through your relationship with your ONE?

Read John 6:1-15

- In the story of the feeding of the 5,000, the crowd came looking for food, but Jesus used the moment to point them toward something deeper. Can you recall a time you were asking God for something that wasn't your deepest need?
- The boy offered what little he had, and Jesus used it to feed thousands. What is something small that you hesitate (or fear) to offer to God because it doesn't feel like enough?
- Where have you seen Jesus meet an impossible need? Share.
- When a prayer remains unanswered, what tends to happen inside you first—trust, frustration, doubt, resignation, or something else? What experience or understanding created that habitual reaction in your life now?
- Where have you seen Jesus stretch a gift beyond its means? Share.
- Where in your life are you dissatisfied with God's action or inaction? How has He sustained you in that situation
