1 LIFE engagement question

ONE aim: To see God at work in the relationships He has placed around us and join Him in His work. Praying for others in this and sharing stories builds our faith and gives us courage. Be patient and extend grace to one another as each one of you devotes yourselves to following Jesus' lead in your relationships. Everyone does not need to share each time you meet. Let God lead and do the work.

In what ways have you surrendered to God's lead with your ONE?

Read John 6:16-25

Discuss:

- As you read, what stands out to you? Share with the group.
- When the disciples saw Jesus walking on the water, their fear increased before they recognized Him. Have you ever experienced a moment where encountering God's power or presence made you feel unsettled or overwhelmed before it brought peace? What was that like for you?
- Think about a moment in your life when you realized God was bigger or more powerful than you previously understood. How did that realization affect your trust or obedience?
- Does "fear of God" make you uncomfortable? Can you trace backwards to where that belief or discomfort began?
- Jesus' first words were, "It is I; do not be afraid." Why do you think reassurance so often follows moments where people encounter God's power?
- The disciples were terrified until they heard Jesus' voice. Then they invited him into the boat and immediately they found safety, both spiritual and physical. When's the last time you casted your anxiety on Jesus and found yourself filled with more peace?
- In John 14:5-14 Jesus talks about being the way, the truth, and the life. He talks about the disciples being able to do more miracles and even greater ones than He if they believe and call on His Name. He will glorify the Father if we ask in Jesus' name. What kinds of questions does this raise in your mind? Is there something holding you back from praying big prayers?
