Community Group Questions: Eph 2:10 & Peter 4:10

- Remember:
 - We love and serve God by grace, through faith. But we love and serve others through works. God does not need our work. But people do. God invites us to partner with him through work in order to bless others.
 - The Reformers in the 16th century suggested that we all have the same “vocation” or “calling,” which is to love our neighbor through our work. But we have different “stations,” which are different relationships and responsibilities.
 - We can have many stations at one time in life. And our stations change throughout life (as our relationships and responsibilities change).
- Describe the first time you felt compelled to “serve God” with a specific behavior, activity or event. What did you do? And what did it feel like?
- Do you have a sense that God has “chosen you” for a relationship? Specifically, does it feel to you like God became involved with your life during a specific season of life? Why do you think some people sense God’s involvement and others don’t?
- Looking back, how can you see God’s hand preparing you for your current “station?”
- As you try to serve him in your current station, how do you notice him shaping you?
- Do you think people experience the Spirit of God when they interact with you at work? (either as “customers/clients” or as “coworkers”)
