Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-7

- Garrett talked about how sometimes we read this passage and think Paul is telling that God rewards financial generosity with financial gain. But that's not what Paul is suggesting. Instead, he means those who are generous with their time, money, and talent reap a harvest of Kingdom Fruit.
 - Why might viewing this passage as financial generosity for greater financial gain be dangerous?
 - How is your faith the result of someone else's generosity?
 - What is "Kingdom Fruit?"
 - Read 2 Corinthians 9:12-13 for a clue.
