

## April 26 Discussion Questions

**Read: 1 Corinthians 3:16-17; 6:19-20. Ephesians 2:21-22**

1. ONE AWARE QUESTION: Pray for each other and their ONEs in your meeting time - you could partner up and pray, or have each person pray for the small group member and their ONE on their left or right, etc.
2. When you hear “you are God’s temple,” what feels most clear to you—and what feels difficult to actually believe or live out?
3. These passages describe both you (personally) and you all (all y’all) as God’s temple. Where do you see tension between personal spirituality and shared, communal faith?
4. 1 Corinthians 6 frames the body as something we “honor” because it belongs to God. What does honoring your body realistically look like in your current season of life?
5. Ephesians describes believers being “built together” into a dwelling place for God. What kinds of relationships or practices have actually helped shape your spiritual life over time?
6. 1 Corinthians 3 warns against “destroying” God’s temple. What habits, influences, or thought patterns tend to erode your sense of being a place where God dwells?
7. If you took this idea seriously for the next week—that God’s Spirit lives in and among you—what is one small, specific change you would make?
