## **Community Group Questions: Acts 6:1-7**

- Have you ever been part of a small group or small community who shared freely with each other? If so, what were the strengths and weaknesses of that experience? If not, what do you imagine would be great and not-so-great about that kind of life?

- Sometimes churches are criticized for being too "business-like." What if the

  roles and responsibilities? Does that kind of "business practice" make a church more or
  less effective today? Why do you think so?
- What does it say to you that the apostles refused to serve tables because of their devotion to "prayer and ministry of the word?"
- What does it say to you that people who were chosen to serve tables were required to be "full of the Spirit and wisdom?"
- How do you feel about your own investment of grace in your community of faith?
