

The Compass Study Guide

These study pages are for groups and individuals to deepen their reflection on the biblical passages from the sermon and work toward group and personal application of His word. They can be completed in one sitting or over the week. Together, we are learning and living the Bible.

Heroes & Zeros Series "Solomon: A Foolish Wise Guy"

1 Kings 1-11

If you have not heard Pastor Rusty's sermon this week, take some time to listen to it online before continuing with the questions.

Read 1 Kings 3:9-13, 6:1-10; 8:23-30.

Solomon was greatly blessed and talented as Israel's third king. In addition to writing three of Israel's cherished scriptures (Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon and Proverbs), he had many other noteworthy achievements and traits.

List what made Solomon a great man (skim the rest of 1 Kings: 1-10, if needed):

God is not impressed with the splendor of kings like Solomon, but which of Solomon's traits would you say are God-pleasing?

What makes YOU great? Which of YOUR traits would you say are God-pleasing?

Read 1 Kings 6:12-13, 8:46-51 and 9:6-7.
What did God ask of the Israelites and of Solomon as their king?
How is this similar to what God asks of you, and of our leaders today?
God had a covenant with Israel (and Solomon). Do you have a similar covenant relationship with God? Why or why not?
Read 1 Kings 3:3; 11:1-6; 11:29-33 and Deuteronomy 17:16-17.
Solomon definitely enjoyed a time of blessing and even greatness as king of Israel, but his actions eventually led to ruin. What would you say was behind Solomon's turning away from God? Was it the fault of his many wives, who led him astray? Explain.
What was Solomon pursuing that led him astray?
In your own life, what moments of prosperity and blessing have been followed by disobedience and painful consequences?

What has led you astray?
Is there some sense that you (and Solomon) exchanged the truth of God for a lie? What is the lie that leads you away from God? What can you do to remain in the center of God's will? How can you defeat the lie?
Read 1 Kings 11:34 and 1 Timothy 6:6-10.
Solomon had achieved much, but his human achievement earned him nothing.
How then, do you earn anything in God's economy? How then should you live?
Although God pronounced consequences on Israel for Solomon breaking the covenant with Him, God still gave one tribe to David's line.
What does this say about God?
What does this say about your relationship with God?
vital does this say about your relationship with G00?


