Base Camp Discussion Questions

1. Which of the following words most accurately describes your relationship with the Holy Spirit: distant, intimate, confusing, mysterious, exhilarating, fearful, or something else? Explain.
2. Who or what has made the greatest impact on your current understanding of the Spirit (e.g. pastor, teacher, book, class, etc.)? In what ways did that affect you?
3. Read 1 Cor. 14:1-5. What strikes you from this passage, especially with respect to “dynamic prophecy?” Have you ever experienced specific guidance from the Holy Spirit? If you feel comfortable, please share.
4. Gather together in groups of two and ask the Holy Spirit if there is a word that strengthens, encourages, or comforts the person you are praying over (1 Cor. 14:3). Share what you feel He may be saying.
