

## **Fake News: *The Illusion of Happiness***

**Fake News = The production of propaganda to get you to believe something that is not true or only partially true.**

*2 Cor. 4:6-7*

1. God hid His *treasure* in a place that most people won't think to look.....within *us*.

**Fake News #1:** We keep searching for something we already *have*.

*2 Cor. 5:17*

**Fake News #2:** When expression (Jar of clay) poses as *source* (treasure), frustration is the result.

When expression yields to source, *fulfillment* is inevitable.

*2 Cor. 5:1-5*

**Fake News #3:** That our *condition* in Christ is our *position* in Christ.

- Condition in Christ = Subject to Change  
*1 Cor. 9:26-27, Phil. 1:6*
- Position in Christ = Never Changes  
*2 Cor. 5:21, Rom. 5:17-19, 2 Cor. 4:16*
- Old Testament Example of this: Zech. 3:1-5

**Fake News #4:** When what we *feel* becomes more important than what we *know*.

*In 2019, I challenge you to discipline your mind to believe the truth about your position in Christ. (Fly by your instruments)*

*Also, I want to challenge all of us at the Ascent Church this year to improve our condition in Christ by pressing in and engaging in spiritual and physical disciplines.*

## **Ammunition Scriptures To Meditate On That Confirm My Position In Christ!**

2 Corinthians 4:6-7 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness, made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ. But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

2 Corinthians 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Romans 5:17-19 For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ! Consequently, just as one trespass resulted in condemnation for all people, so also one righteous act resulted in justification and life for all people. For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.

Romans 8:15 The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."

John 15:15 I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you.

2 Corinthians 1:21, 22 Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us, set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

Ephesians 1:13,14 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory.

Romans 8:17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

Romans 8:1-4 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, <sup>2</sup>because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death. <sup>3</sup>For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in the flesh, <sup>4</sup>in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

## **Ammunition Scriptures To Meditate On That Will Challenge Me To Improve My Condition In Christ!**

2 Corinthians 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.

Philippians 1:6 being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

1 Corinthians 9:26-27 Therefore I do not run like someone running aimlessly; I do not fight like a boxer beating the air. No, I strike a blow to my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Ephesians 4:24 and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

Psalms 119: 9-11 How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to your word. I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

Ephesians 4:1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.
