

## **Message Notes**

Sermon Passages: Luke 15:4-10.



#### **Shared Engagement and Preparation**

The Compass is a daily devotional and study guide for individuals, families, and Base Camps. The Compass has Biblical reflections for each day, beginning on Monday and leading up to Sunday, which will help us all meditate on the week's passage. In this way, the whole of the church engages in God's Word and prepares for our time of worship and preaching.

#### **Deep Engagement and Doable Application**

In order to allow for deep impact by God through His Word, The Compass centers on one passage in three ways — as individuals, with others, in our corporate gatherings — and focuses on applying what God is showing us. Life transformation happens when God's people depend upon and live out what He has revealed to us in His Word.

#### **Consistency Over Time**

With a tool such as The Compass, we can mistakenly measure personal spiritual success or failure based on whether we've completed a given day's reflection. Instead, use The Compass as a resource for individual and community growth. If you miss a few days, move on, pick it up from the next day, and seek maturity—God will honor this.

Our prayer is that God will bless you as you seek to connect intimately with Him, intentionally with His people, and influentially in His world.

The Compass Passages for 5/9/16–5/14/16: Luke 19:12-27.

### Monday, May 9, 2016

<b>Read:</b> Luke 19:12-27 through several times in various Bible versions.
Reflect: What do you think the main point of this parable is?
Who are the characters in this story? List all you see.
Draw a timeline of the story below. Identify key events.
What transforming thoughts and/or actions were revealed to you this week, and how might you put them into practice?
Spend some time in quiet prayer with God. Ask Him to interpret

this parable for you. Listen carefully for His response. Don't be

afraid of the quiet while you wait to hear His voice.

#### **Tuesday, May 10, 2016**

**Read:** Luke 19:12-27 and Matthew 25:14-30. Many believe these are two versions of the same parable.

#### Reflect:

What do you see as similarities and differences between these two parable accounts?

Do these differences change the main point of the parables? If so, how would you state the contrasts?

What transforming thoughts and/or actions were revealed to you this week, and how might you put them into practice?

How might this parable apply to your life today?

## Wednesday, May 11, 2016

Read: Luke 19:12-27 and then record the parable in your own words, using the space below.
Reflect: How is God using this parable to speak to you this week? Find a friend or member of your Base Camp and share what you have learned.
What transforming thoughts and/or actions were revealed to you this week, and how might you put them into practice?
Spend time quietly listening to God after asking Him, "What do you want me to learn from this parable?"

#### **Thursday, May 12, 2016**

Read: Luke 19:12-27.

#### Reflect:

Now that you have been looking at this parable for a few days, explore who Jesus might have been portraying in the story.

Who do you think was the *nobleman* in this story?

Who were the *servants* who were given the money?

Who were the *subjects* who didn't want the nobleman to be their king?

What do you think the *distant country* represented in the story?

Who was the third servant?

Has answering these questions given you a different perspective on the parable? Why or why not?

What transforming thoughts and/or actions were revealed to you this week, and how might you put them into practice?

Who in the parable do you most relate to? Why?

#### Friday, May 13, 2016

**Read:** Luke 19:12-27.

#### Reflect:

How does reading this parable in different versiona give additional insight or questions for your study?

What transforming thoughts and/or actions were revealed to you this week, and how might you put them into practice?

What resources or talents has God given you to use for His kingdom?

If God were to return today, what would you tell Him you have gained with the resources you have been given?

If you were given a chance to change how you are using the resources and talents God has given you, what would you change?

#### Saturday, May 14, 2016

Read: Luke 19:12-27.

#### Reflect:

Look back on your notes from this week. Take time to ask God what He wants you to do differently after your study.

Put together an action plan for the coming month, practicing what you feel God is calling you to do. Put that plan somewhere visible so you will be reminded of it throughout the month.

Be prepared to share your plans with someone in your family or Base Camp and ask them to help you be accountable for putting the plan into action.

What transforming thoughts and/or actions were revealed to you this week, and how might you put them into practice?

Take time today to prepare your heart for worship with fellow believers tomorrow. Ask God to use you in someone's life as you prepare to worship and respond to God's calling.

#### **Building Our Base Camp Family**

This is week three of our suggested four-week pattern for Base Camps: intergenerational, adult study, <u>mixed</u>, invitation/service. Each week will have an intergenerational element (such as the meal); then there will be a focus for the meeting that follows the pattern and is attentive to God's Word and the age mix.

**Prepare:** Read Luke 19:12-27 as a group, and discuss what stands out to you.

Keep in mind that your group is made of of different ages and experiences. God is present and wants to use each member of the group to speak into each others lives.

#### Mixed:

Share insights that have been gained from reading the passages this week.

How did God challenge you through the Compass this week, through this passage and through the message?

Take time to discuss how this passage relates to your life.

- -What talents has God entrusted to you?
- -How can you multiply those talents?
- -What actions do you need to take in light of what you learned?

How can you, as a Base Camp, support one another in multiplying the talents God has given you?


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#### Mission and Vision
