BASE CAMP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

3. Sanballat and Tobiah jeered at Nehemiah and God's people who were working on the wall. They wanted to stop God's work. Describe some of the opposition you've experienced in your personal walk of faith.

4. What are some of the ways you can see our culture provides opposition to the church? To you, your marriage, your family?

5. Is it possible that you might be providing opposition to what God wants to accomplish in some way? How can you change this?

6. What are some steps you can take to respond to the opposition you experience in a healthy and God-honoring way?
