

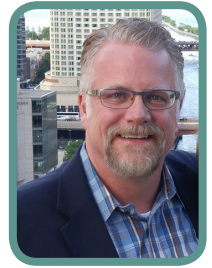

Base Camp Discussion Questions

Read Revelation 19:11-21. This passage describes The Second Coming of Jesus to take His place as The King. What strikes you as you read this passage about Jesus?

Revelation 21:1-2 says the following:

Then I saw “a new heaven and a new earth,” for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea .2 I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

If God is going to create a new heaven and a new earth, what are the implications of that for your life? Think of it this way. If there are great places of beauty and glory on this planet now, imagine what such places will be like without the taint of sin our “old” world has now. Let your imagination picture what this could be like and discuss what such a future reality means for you today.

Was there anything new you learned today from the sermon?

How will you act on what you’ve learned this week?

Preview: Next week, we’ll begin a new series entitled “Climbing Together.” You can prepare for this by reading Nehemiah 9-10.
