



These study pages are for groups and individuals to deepen their reflection on the biblical passages from the sermon and work toward group and personal application of His word. They can be completed in one sitting or over the week. Together, we are learning and living the Bible.

Better Families Series "King Saul"

1 Samuel 8-15, 1 Samuel 13:1-18, 1 Samuel 15:1-35

If you have not heard Pastor Rusty's sermon this week, take some time to listen to it online before continuing with the questions.

Read 1 Samuel 13:1-18 slowly, letting God speak to you through His Word.

What was the sin that Saul committed in this passage? When he was asked about his actions, what did Saul do?

Read 2 Samuel 15:1-35 through.

What was the sin that Saul committed in this passage? How did Samuel deal with Saul's actions and what was Saul's response?

What was the result of this pattern of sin in Saul's life and his refusal to admit it when confronted?
List the main points from Pastor Rusty's sermon below:
How do you respond when someone confronts you regarding sin in your life?
Take some time in quiet prayer today, asking God to show you where you have developed habits of sin and request that He give you the ability to repent and break these habits.
If necessary, find a close friend who is willing to help you stay accountable in breaking the sin habits you have developed within your life.

What was the most important lesson you learned from this study of King Saul? How will you put into practice what you have learned?

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
