These study pages are for groups and individuals to deepen their reflection on the biblical passages from the sermon and work toward group and personal application of His word. They can be completed in one sitting or over the week. Together, we are learning and living the Bible.

Heroes & Zeros Series "King Uzziah: A Tragic Success" 2 Chronicles 26

If you were not able to hear Pastor Rusty's sermon today, take some time to listen to it online. Open your time of study in prayer, asking God to show you how to apply the challenges from His Word.

Before reviewing the life of King Uzziah as recorded in 2 Chronicles 26, review the following instructions Jesus gave in the Sermon on the Mount:

Read Matthew 6:1. Beware of what?

Read Matthew 6:24. What keeps you from truly serving God?

Read Matthew 6:33. What should you seek in life?

Kings, in the Old Testament, were instructed to model this kind of life so the people could and would follow their example. With this in mind, look at the Old Testament King Uzziah.

Read 2 Chronicles 26:1-5, and fill in the blanks to the following statements from verses 4 and 5:

"He [Uzziah] did ______ was _____ in the eyes of the LORD."

"He _____ God during the days of Zechariah, who instructed him in the _____ of God. As long as he _____ the LORD, God gave him success."

What did King Uzziah (and every king serving God's people) need to do in order to fulfill what was right in the eyes of the LORD?

What did Uzziah need to do to be assured that he was truly seeking the LORD?

Why was it important for Uzziah be instructed to fear God? (See Proverbs 1:7, 3:7-8, 9:10, 10:27, 14:26-27, 19:23)

Read 2 Chronicles 26:6-15 and make a list of Uzziah's accomplishments while being faithful to God:

Read 2 Chronicles 26:16-23. What did Uzziah do wrong? (See 26:16-18)

What was the consequence of his sin? (See 26:19-23)

Go back and review Matthew 6:1, 24, and 33. How did Uzziah violate these instructions?

How can you, a person of God today, put into practice these teachings of Jesus so as to be a model to the world? What do you need in order to accomplish God's desire? What do you need to do?

What primary message from God rises to the surface for you after reflecting upon these passages of Scripture?


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Mission and Vision
