

The Compass Study Guide

These study pages are for groups and individuals to deepen their reflection on the biblical passages from the sermon and work toward group and personal application of His word. They can be completed in one sitting or over the week. Together, we are learning and living the Bible.

Better Families Series "King David"

1 Samuel 15, 2 Samuel 12

If you have not heard Taylor's sermon this week, take some time to listen to it online before continuing with the questions.

Read: I Samuel 15:11 and II Samuel 12:7-9 (if you like, read all of I Samuel 15 and all of II Samuel 11 & 12 for the whole stories.)

Saul and David were special kings of Israel - Paul the first anointed king, and David the beloved king who gave his name to the lineage of the Messiah. Yet, in these passages, you read that both had tragic failings.

List several reasons why leaders "fall":

What are leaders (particularly of God's people) called to do?

Do you hold leaders to a different standard? Why? What Biblical standard would you set for a leader?
Even if you do not have a title, position or authority, could you still be considered a leader? How?
What standard do you set for yourself as a leader?
Read: I Samuel 24:1-10 & 26:8-12; Romans 13:1-5 and Acts 23:2-5
In these passages, you see that God's Word directs you to respect authorityeven when you are mistreated (Saul trying to kill David, pagan Romans persecuting Christians, and the High Priest directing Paul's persecution).
If men of God respected authority even as they were persecuted by authority, what does that say about how you should regard authorities today?
In what ways do you disregard or disrespect authority?

Read: I Timothy 2:1-2 Besides praying for your leaders, what else might you do to help them? As you lift up your leaders in prayer, pray also for yourself - that you would have the courage to step in and support or carry out the work of your leaders - perhaps be a leader yourself. Pray you would have grace and respect for your leaders. Read: Any Psalm by David--e.g. Psalm 1, 18, 23, or 51; and Acts 13:22 Although David was flawed, he was still called a "man after God's own heart." In reading David's Psalms, what redeeming, Godhonoring traits do you see in David? If God commands such high respect for authority (ref. verses from previous section), what does this imply for leaders' behaviors? Why has God asked you to respect authority?

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
