


EQUIPPING MINISTRY

The Compass Study Guide

These study pages are for groups and individuals to deepen their reflection on the biblical passages from the sermon and work toward group and personal application of His word. They can be completed in one sitting or over the week. Together, we are learning and living the Bible.

Heroes & Zeros Series "King Hezekiah: A Second Chance"

2 Kings 18-20

If you were not able to hear Pastor Rusty's sermon today, take some time to listen to it online. Open your time of study in prayer, asking God to show you how to apply the challenges from His Word.

Read 2 Kings 18:28–30, 32b–35; Psalm 37:7–13

Hezekiah, one of the "righteous" and revered kings of Judah, was challenged by Sennacherib of Assyria—to the point of some very demoralizing threats and bold blasphemy of Israel's God.

When the wicked prosper or threaten God's people, what can you do?

Why does God allow oppression of His people?

Read 2 Kings 19:14-37

Does this passage explain why God allows the wicked to prosper for a season?

As with Judah in today's passage, God is merciful to you. What impact does God's mercy have on you? On others in your life?

What is God's purpose in punishing the wicked?

What is God's purpose in showing mercy?

Read 2 Kings 18:5–7; 2 Chronicles 31:20–21, 32:25; 2 Kings 20:1–11

Again, Scripture records a "righteous" king of Judah who has a crisis in character that leads to near tragedy. However, God is merciful, and Hezekiah was given a second chance.

Could you argue that Hezekiah was good and righteous and deserved this second chance? Why or why not?

What purpose could this second chance serve in Hezekiah's life?
How about you? What second chances have you had?
What purpose did they serve?
How could you make the argument that all of life is a second chance?
Read Isaiah 38:15–17 This is Hezekiah's prayer. Write your own prayer here:


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Mission and Vision
