Theologian and writer, Frederick Buechner, said, "To confess your sins to God is not to tell [God] anything [God] doesn't already know. Until you confess them, however, they are the abyss between you. When you confess them, they become the bridge." Why are we so hesitant to confess sin at times and experience this wonderful bridge?
