These study pages are for groups and individuals to deepen their reflection on the biblical passages from the sermon and work toward group and personal application of His word. They can be completed in one sitting or over the week. Together, we are learning and living the Bible.

# Heroes & Zeros Series "King Jeroboam: An Irreverent Rebel"

1 Kings 12-14

If you were not able to hear Pastor Scott's sermon today, take some time to listen to it online. Open your time of study in prayer, asking God to show you how to apply the challenges from His Word.

The passages you're about to read are preceded by the account of King Solomon's betrayal of God's covenant with him (Solomon) as king. This betrayal brought serious consequences. Kings were supposed to keep God's statutes and commandments. They were to listen to God and follow God's ways as leaders of God's people. Not to do so brought devastating consequences.

**Read** 1 Kings 11:26–40. Describe in your own words what God is doing with Jeroboam in this story.

Covenants involve two conditions. The first condition explains the requirements of the covenant, using the qualifying statement "IF YOU WILL (followed by the requirements)." The second condition explains the consequences of the covenant, using the qualifying statement, "THEN I WILL (followed by the consequences)." Read again 1 Kings 11:35–38. What are the two conditions of God's covenant with Jeroboam?
Describe various covenants that exist in your society today (not with God, but with one another). What are the conditions of these covenants?
<b>Read</b> 1 Kings 12:1–5, 12–15, and 25–33. Describe in your own words the basic elements of this story. What is happening?
1 Kings 13 tells the story of the prophets' turn against Jeroboam and also how they turned from God's ways. Read 1 Kings 13:18–25. What is happening here?

**Read** 1 Kings 13:33–34 and 14:1–10. What, in your opinion, is the primary revelation from these verses?

**Read** John 3:3, 16–21 and Romans 10:9–13. These verses are only a few of many in the New Testament that point to the covenant God offers today. What is this covenant? What are the conditions of this covenant? If you have agreed to this covenant, how is it affecting the way you live?


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#### **Mission and Vision**
