	d)	omnipotence -to have unlimited authority or influence (Philippians 3:20-21, cf. also Isaiah 9:6; Revelation 1:8)
	e)	immutability - not capable of or susceptible to change (Hebrews 1:10-12; cf. also Hebrews 13:8).
