Review: What Happens When a Believer Dies?

If I am a believer, when I die...

- 1. When? Immediately
- 2. With who? Jesus
- 3. Where? In Paradise
- 4. For the believer, death means to be <u>carried</u> by <u>angels</u> to <u>Abraham's side</u>
- 5. For the believer, death means to go to a place where you will be...
 - a. Comforted
 - b. Experience gain, not loss.
 - c. Experience something far better.
- 6. For a believer, to die means to be <u>away</u> from the body and at <u>home</u> with the Lord.

Philippians 3:20-4:1

- **1.** As a believer, I am . . .
 - a) ... <u>waiting</u> for Jesus to come from <u>heaven</u>
 - b) ... to transform my "lowly" body
 - c) ... so that it will be like his <u>glorious</u> body.
