- 1. Origins: described in Exodus 25:10-22; built in Exodus 37
- 2. Intended location: in the tabernacle in **Exodus 26:31-35**
- 3. Caretakers: Kohathites in Numbers 3:17, 27, 31; 4:4-6, 15
- Contents: Hebrews 9:4
 Purpose: Leviticus 16

Where has the ark of the covenant recently been?

- 1 Samuel 4: Philistines capture it (seven months)
- 1 Samuel 5: Philistines move it around Philistia
- 1 Samuel 6: Philistines return it to Beth-shemesh
- 1 Samuel 7: Taken to Abinidab in Kiriath-jearim (Baale-judah) (20 years)
