Psalm 22:3 (KJV)

...Thou art holy, O Thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel.

Psalm 22:3 (ESV)

...You are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel.

Shachah (Hebrew): To depress, prostrate, bow down flat.

Proskuneo (Greek): To kiss toward, to prostrate oneself before.

Tehillah (Hebrew): A song or hymn of praise and adoration.

Halal (Hebrew): To be clamorously foolish, to boast, to make a show.

Yadah (Hebrew): To throw out, stretch, or extend the hands.

Abad (Hebrew): To work, to labour.

Latreuo (Greek): NT equivalent for serving, perform priestly duty.

Barak (Hebrew): To bend the knee and bow down.
