Nicene Creed Sermon 4

- 1. Who for us men and for our salvation, came down from heaven. What does this mean to you?
- 2. The Christ's birth came according to God's perfect timing. Over two thousand years later, what context do we have as to why it was the perfect time?
- 3. The virgin birth is a miracle that fulfills prophecy. What does the fact that He did not have a human father mean? With God's perfect execution of the arrival of Jesus, how can anyone argue that Jesus is not the incarnate Messiah?
- 4. Jesus is holy and human. What is the significance that while being fully God, He is also fully man? How does the fact that He suffered fully as man make you feel about his sacrifices for our salvation? Do you accept Jesus Christ as your Lord and savior?
- 5. Do you believe that Jesus, being a man as well as God, means that He understands, hears, sympathizes, and helps you? Do you believe that you will be saved because Jesus is the perfect savior that defeated death, hell, and Satan?
