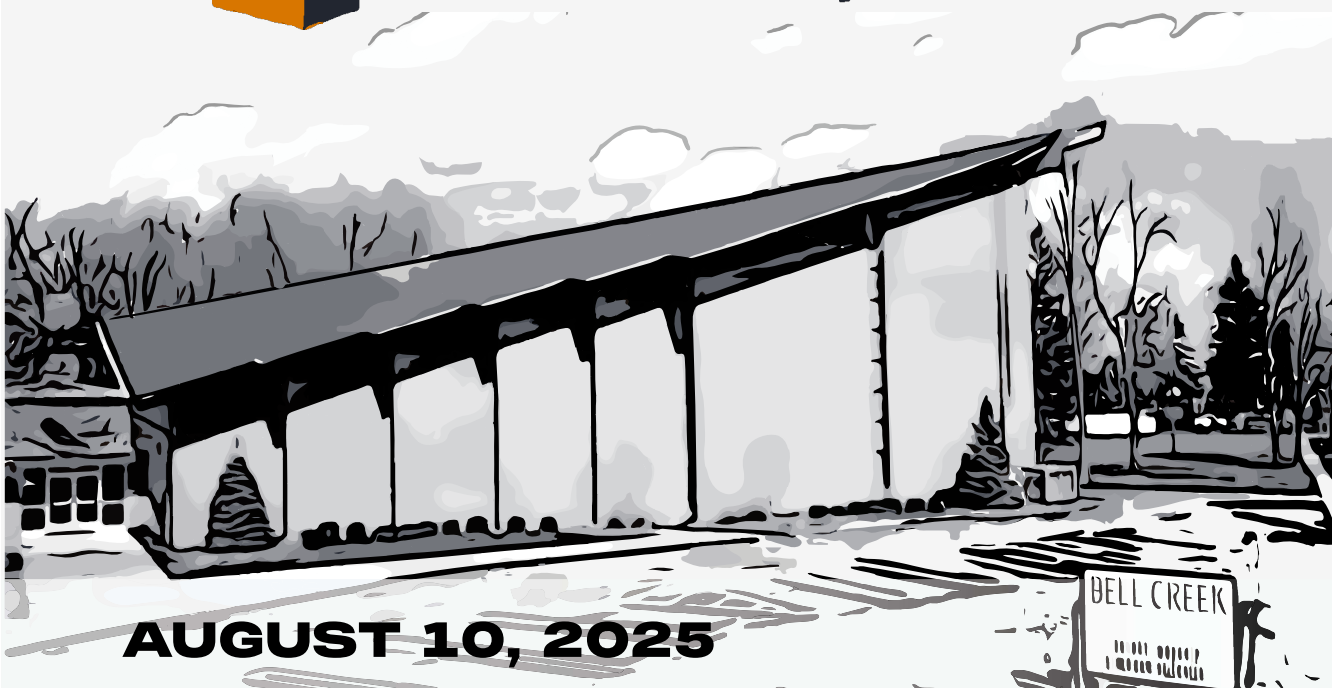

MATTHEW 28:19–20

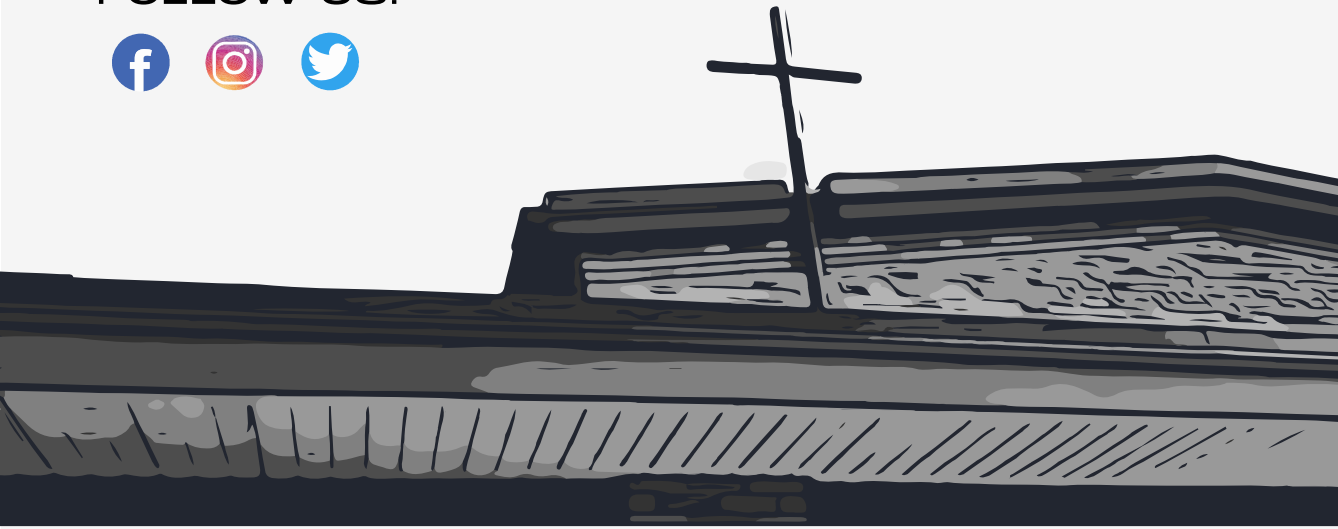

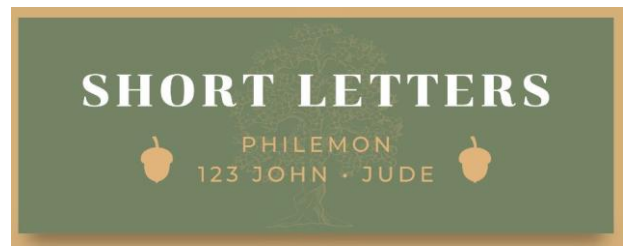
