

## **FAMILY UPDATE**

#### We came home to:

- 1. Raise support: Slow to start but now on track. This was slow because honestly, we have served overseas for the children's entire lives, they were not used to America, and it was a cultural challenge. For the first time, we dealt with teen depression and hard talks were had. It was very scary for me as a parent. This is VERY COMMON for 3rd culture kids and I sought a therapist to help with advice, the school supported us, a lot of prayers happened, and the children's pediatrician made some calls to help the children get pro-bono ski passes. I know this sounds funny! But skiing brought HOPE. We found out that Acacia can not eat enriched foods. Now that she has changed her diet, she is absorbing iron and vitamin B, feeling amazing, and is back to being my "take over the world" Acacia. She woke up one day and said, "I need to speak with the vice president." Haha, I knew she was back. (This month I am finally able to start meeting, preaching, and teaching as I just got back from Tanzania.)
- 2. Get Enoch and Noella settled in the USA: <u>Success</u> Their citizenship had a hang-up but they did get work visas. They have since finished their driver's ed courses and are working on getting licenses and learning to drive. (Pray for me as I am now a driver's ed teacher to them). Enoch builds million-dollar homes and works with an awesome godly group of men. He loves his job. He is freezing but loves it. Noella works at Walgreens and loves her job equally. They are both saving for cars and trying to find a friend in Maine. We live kind of rural, so pray for them.
- 3. Build a USA-based team to help expand the Tanzania base vision to start a FIRE AFRICA and expand PROJECT LOVE: Success would be an understatement of this! Thank you, Jesus. We have Paula Keck from Texas, Taphath Canon from Colorado, and NOW Chris and Jamie Bottoms from Alaska and we are looking for 1 more couple and a few more individuals to help. - 4. Expand Project Love and Launch the Internship Program: Success I was nervous to be abroad at first, but then it just started to work. I have teams on the ground that make this possible: a national team and an international team. They are amazing and make this all possible. The internship program is going to be awesome.
