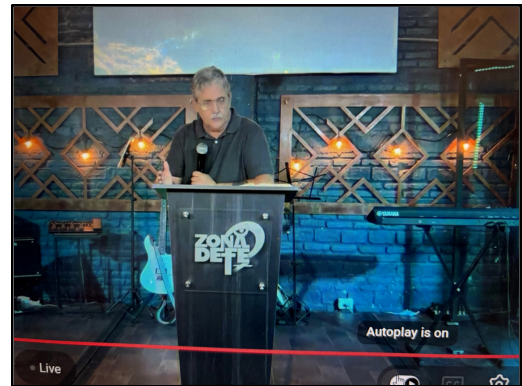
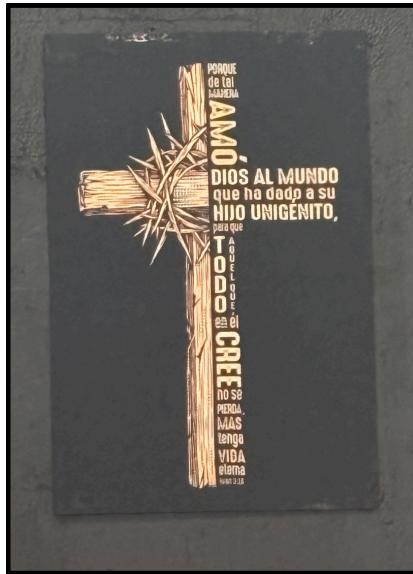
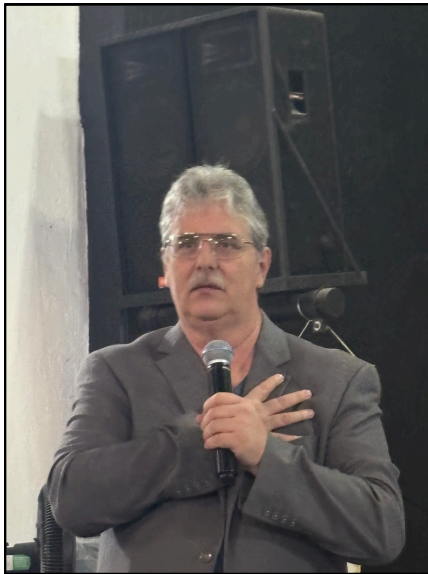

This caused a minor heart attack. But she is doing much better and Praise God for keeping her safe. It was good to visit them on Friday night, June 5<sup>th</sup>.
