I was invited by the pastor of the town to come on April 22, 2024 and explain what the Lord said. There were about twelve people of five denominations represented and after sending out the message from the Lord, I was asked when is my return day to the USA, and I told them May 8, 2024. They asked me if I can comeback back on May 5, 2024 so they can invite other denominations because they were not aware. I was there on that date and described again what the Lord said and when I was done speaking I sat down. The president of the church in that town took the mic. He said, "God gave the same vision to a pastor years back and everything was going on well but the pastor died two years ago and the vision took a downturn, so God sent another person from the USA to remind the church and this time there is no slackening."





We acknowledged the Lord with public expressions of praise, worship, adoration of our King of kings, Lord of lords, and God of gods as you can see below. I will be going back in August 2024 for the next move as evangelism is already going on by God's grace.











Also LOVELIFE Cameroon is soaring by the hand of God and sixteen babies have been saved from abortion in Cameroon even though our greatest challenge is in the area of financing to increase the number of babies to be saved, but God always make a way where there seems to be no way at the last moment.

LOVELIFE Cameroon authorization came out after a long battle and we were approved to march in the capital Yaoundé during the National Labor Day of May 1, 2024 in-front of the government authorities and many souls were also won before and after the march.
