England Our trip started in Crewe, England with our dear friends and missionaries Phil and Emma Howell and Emma's parents Geoff and Sandra Willetts. Hope Church has recently acquired a new long term lease in an old military armory building that has been totally revamped for the work of the Gospel!!!! After years of borrowing other buildings and having to set up everything every week, it is wonderful to have their own permanent place for worship and other church activities.

In addition to their sanctuary, they also have a wonderful café where delicious cakes and desserts are made fresh for sale as well as sandwiches and of course, tea and coffee!! The community is coming in and enjoying the peace and delicious food!!! They also have a grocery store that is designed with the less fortunate in mind. It is kind of like a co-op type idea. You pay a really low price and then a greatly reduced price for the items you buy. Some are donated and others are greatly subsidized by grants. This is another great outreach opportunity!!!

The key is people see Hope Church as a place to get their needs met and to connect with the Hope Church family and then come to church or have a Jesus conversation and they meet Jesus!! And it IS happening!!!!

We had a youth meeting on Friday night with several churches represented. Tobi and Karyn led worship and Caleb Myers brought the word and it was powerful! We prayed for all the youth and they received so well. Sunday was church and Tobi and Karyn were part of the worship team. Josh preached on "You Were Made for More"! At the altar call, many came forward for prayer and one lady received salvation!!!! She had been running for awhile, but she slowed down and surrendered!!!! How exciting!! Sunday night was a Holy Ghost night. Josh and Andy shared and God moved. Many were touched in powerful ways.

Germany From there we went on to Germany. We also got to drive through the north part of Switzerland too as we flew into Zurich and then rented a van and drove north to Radolfzell, Germany. Buddy and Taryn Raschdorf and their family have been ministering to refugees and have done a great job!! They have raised up a local Kurdish believer that will now take the group and will care for his people.

We met with two very different groups while we were there. One was more expats and Germans who work in similar outreaches. We had a wonderful night of worship and sharing Jesus. On Friday we met at a lovely lake beach and enjoyed barbecued chicken Kurdish style as we met with the Kurdish community. It was delicious.

Even better, one young man who had recently been saved wanted to be water baptized. Josh had the privilege of chatting with him and praying for him and then we all witnessed his baptism. What a special day!!!



Belgium Saturday we went to Belgium where we met with our missionary, Carol Britton, and our dear friend Walter Cockx. We spent Sunday with Walter at his church, Philadelphia Church. Tobi and Karyn led worship and Josh and Andy shared. It was a powerful service!!! Several people were healed, especially one young lady, Esther, who had had severe back pain for over three years. Josh felt the pain and knew it was a Word of Knowledge. When he spoke it out, she fell to the ground in tears as she felt the pain leave!!! God is so faithful!!!!



Our flight home was uneventful and we are very glad to be safely home. Thank you for your support in prayer and finances. Europe is expensive, but it was definitely worth every penny!!!!
