Pray for Kryvyi Rih & Ukraine: Things are very difficult right now in Kryvyi Rih. There are attacks every day by either drone or missile strikes. The attacks on the energy infrastructure has been quite damaging. The power outage schedule is extreme! Most homes only have two to three hours of power during the day, and again two to three hours in the middle of the night. Some homes have had no power for several days at a time. Which for some also means no water and some have no heat. It is an incredibly difficult time! Pray for our city, for the churches, for believers. It is so hard to live in these circumstances during the winter. For families with children it is beyond difficult. Pray for there to be a breakthrough and for Jesus to bring comfort and peace during this literal dark time!

Christmas & New Years: We celebrated Samuel's first Christmas here in Kryvyi Rih with his Babushka as well as our church friends, who are like family to us! We had a really wonderful time. On New Years we prayed in the New Year and Samuel slept right through it of course!

Christmas Celebrations: During the holidays I had several opportunities to visit the Greenfield ladies with our team.
