Our men’s and women’s groups at church have Bible study courses every fall and spring. Moriah is taking the women’s study right now; it’s called “Women of Strength and Courage.” She’s getting to walk through the study with other young women, and the Lord is really speaking to her through this study. It’s so fun to watch our kids grow in the Lord! Both of the girls are helping with childcare at the church. Moriah attends the morning session of the Bible study and does childcare for the evening session. Gabi does both, and they also help with childcare for the Monday night “Hearing God’s Voice” course. Both of those started in February and will go through the end of March. They enjoy working with children.

Our youth group has an “International I Love Food” event every February, but it’s really more of a mission night! Each of the last two years, our event focused on four different countries. Kids learned about the countries, what it’s like to be a Christian in those countries, ate food from each country, and prayed for needs. This year, we did things a bit differently, with a focus on 5 countries, video messages from missionaries in those countries, and prayer rooms students could go in to pray for mission needs in each country and write letters of encouragement to the missionaries. We had a 5-course meal that included food from each country. The countries or regions we highlighted were West Africa, Central Asia, USA/Tacoma (homeless ministry), Turkmenistan, and Rwanda and Zambia. Our leaders also presented mini mission opportunities that the students can get involved with. These include the homeless ministry in Tacoma (Freedom River Outreach) with meals and a clothing drive, a pregnancy support organization, and others.



Greg has started to meet with another person for deeper discipleship. He has been a believer for a while, but lately he has struggled to go deeper in his walk with the Lord and is longing for deeper fellowship and discipleship. So, once a week, as possible, they will be meeting at a local coffee shop and working through the Living Set Free book, which will act as a guide to move the discipleship along.

Concerning the other two guys Greg is currently working with, it has been more of a struggle to meet up regularly. Cameron is still recovering from his back surgery. Because of this, it has been impossible to meet up like before. But he's longing to meet up again once his recovery has progressed enough to get out. Travis has the great challenge of being a single dad who also has to work to make ends meet. However, he still has the desire to meet regularly to study and discuss God's Word and grow as a Christian. Greg would like to be able to meet at least once every two weeks to help Travis keep his focus on moving forward in the Lord. But as it is, life challenges make it very hard. Please pray that Cameron will recover quickly and be able to meet up again on a weekly basis and pray that Travis will be granted windows of opportunity to meet up more regularly.

In June, we'll be making a quick trip back to Missouri to visit Debbie's mom and sister, whom we haven't seen in 2 years! We'll be there over one Sunday. If any churches or groups would like us to visit and share what we've been doing in Washington, please let us know. Visiting our supporting churches looks different than when we were in England, as we can't afford to visit as often or to stay 3 months like we used to! That makes visiting churches difficult, but we'd love to reconnect with churches and individuals as time allows.
