I've also been tagging along with Ignite Movement (College Campus Ministry) at the University of North Carolina Charlotte, since the fall of 2025. On Thursdays, we do evangelism on campus, and the conversations have been fruitful. Each time I'm on campus, God gives me a specific assignment on whom I am to engage in conversations. Some days it can be a student who is looking for community, other days it can be someone who is muslim or of another faith. You never know what conversation God has prepared, but each conversation has been



filled with deep conversation about the gospel. I've seen a couple of students led to Christ, and some walking away to search more about who Jesus is. Many believe that ministry on campus can be challenging, and I do believe it has its challenges, but I have personally felt no resistance from people engaging in conversation about Jesus and the gospel. Keep praying for our colleges, universities, and college campus ministers. This is a huge mission field.
