Dear Friends and Family,

A few weeks ago, we were asked to host our revival group in our home. Over 60 young people filled our living room, kitchen, stairs and hallway. We worshipped and prayed before going out in small teams to evangelize. We asked the Lord for encouraging words for people, wrote those down and attached them to roses to hand out. My team went to Craffle Craze, a waffle shop owned by a family from Thailand. After buying some food, we shared with the lady at the counter, Ann. Chao on our team got a word of knowledge that she had a 12 year old daughter. The woman was now interested in what we were talking about and the message on the rose. She said that she is a Budhist, but her daughter and husband go to church. She said she was never interested in Christianity till just now. The Lord ministered to her heart as she let us pray for her and her family. Please continue to pray for Ann.

Some teams went to the homeless, some went to the hospital and others went downtown. After Croffle Craze my team went to the mall to hand out roses. As we were about to finish, I felt the Holy Spirit nudge me to go into Victoria's Secret and give the employees roses. I was very embarrassed, but the Lord reminded me that no one would go there to share Jesus, but that is exactly where He wants to be. I took one of my guys with me and shared with the cleaning lady, an employee and the manager. They were very touched that we would come and share God's love and a simple gift.

After the outreach, we gathered back at our house and shared testimonies. It was beautiful to hear all the Lord had done.

Next week, Hannah will go on a mission trip to El Salvador. She has been asked to head up the kids ministry teams while she is there. We have seen her grow into a confident leader as she has continued to work in the children's church as a "Bridge Pastor" (she works with kids struggling to be a part of the activities) and she works in the children's Breakthrough ministry (helping non verbal children to encounter God). Please keep her in prayer for safe travels and revival to break out in the community.

I met Devan in the Walmart parking lot. He approached me asking for money as I loaded the groceries into the car. I took him into the shop and let him pick out a drink and some food. He was open for prayer, so I asked him what I can pray for him about. He wanted a job working with a lumber company. After praying, he shared that he loves when people pray for him, because he feels peace. He shared that he often lives in fear on the streets. Please pray for the homeless for a spiritual breakthrough in their mental health and drug/ alcohol abuse. One of the ministries I know that works in the area with the homeless shared that almost 100% of the people on the streets have no life skills, because they had no real fathers in their lives. Please pray for fathers.

Thank you so much for your prayers and support. It has been such a blessing to see all the Lord is doing. We look forward with great excitement for what He has ahead.
