## SUCSESSES THIS PAST YEAR

Jesus completely healed me of stage 4 cancer after a year of “fighting the good fight of faith” without chemotherapy or surgery.

My physical strength is better than ever! I’m going to the gym several days a week and walking 4-6 miles a day on average.

**HALLELUJAH!**

(A year ago I could barely walk).

I share my testimony of healing from stage 4 cancer everywhere I go: at the gym, the grocery store, etc... As a result, many are strengthened in their faith, and I have been able to minister to many for healing and lead people to salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.

Because of your partnership with us, in 2025 we have:

- ministered with Mario Murillo in Charlotte under the big tent;
- ministered at churches in Bowling Green, KY and Rockport, Indiana;
- carried the cross and ministered on the streets of Atlanta and other locations in Georgia;
- taught at a pastors and leaders seminar, held a mass crusade and carried the big cross in the DRC in Africa;
- fed, clothed and ministered to the homeless weekly;
- trained and equipped the saints to do the works of Jesus everywhere we go;
- seen hundreds healed, saved, baptized with the Holy Spirit, and many backsliders restored to their first love.

## CHALLENGES

We faced many challenges in 2025.

Our support went down by about 50% because I was unable to minister much in 2024.

We moved from a 3600 sq ft home to a 999 sq ft apartment.

We sold or gave away almost all our furniture and other possessions.

Although we decided to down-size dramatically, we are extremely content and able to focus more on ministry.

"And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. ## PLANS FOR 2026

We are very excited about this coming year. Since the city of Atlanta has done away with all the homeless encampments, we are connecting with a homeless shelter called Frontline. We will be able to store all our homeless supplies there and minister there as well. They house about four hundred men and women in separate dorms. They also have temporary housing for them for up to ninety days. They feed them three times a day. They want us to help lead their Thursday night outreach on the streets. They have several ministry vans we can use to take teams to the streets to feed, minister and rescue those in need of shelter. This will take our homeless ministry to a much higher and effective level.

## CARRYING THE CROSS

I will be carrying the big cross more this coming year than I ever have before. A local pastor in Fayetteville is going with me as I carry the cross here. The last time we went out with the cross, a lady was healed inside her car of back pain. Two teenagers stopped and asked why we were carrying the cross. We ministered to them and they both surrendered their lives to Jesus. Another young man came up to us as we were putting the cross back in my truck. After ministering to him, he received the baptism with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with tongues.

## BACK TO AFRICA

I will be going back to the DRC for two mass crusades around April.

I will be ministering in churches and equipping the saints to heal the sick, win the lost and do the works of Jesus.
