6. Does Jesus advice about light in Matthew 5 contradict his warning about public faith from Matthew 6? Why or why not?
7. Based upon his life and ministry, what do you think Jesus means by "good works" in Matthew 5?

9. What can you do to reorient your faith around the redemptive work your Creator has placed in your path this week? How can you de-center yourself?
