Getting Started

- What's a story from your childhood that you love to share? Why does it stick in your memory?

Discussions

- Reflecting on the idea of fear and trepidation in sharing our faith, what are some common concerns people may have? How can we address or overcome these fears?
- How do you personally feel about sharing your faith with others? Are there specific fears or concerns that come to mind?
- READ John 9:1-25, what observations can we make about the blind man's encounter with Jesus and his willingness to share his experience despite potential challenges?

- The passage emphasizes that Christians are called to share Jesus with others. How do you interpret this calling in your own life? What steps can you take to fulfill this calling?
- What encouragement or insights can we draw from the concept that there is a way to engage in faith conversations without having all the answers? How does this impact our approach to sharing Jesus with others?
- Have you ever been in a situation where you felt unequipped or unsure about sharing your faith? How did you navigate that experience, and what did you learn from it?
- Why is authenticity in faith conversations so important? How can being genuine about our own doubts and uncertainties create a more meaningful dialogue with others?
- How can we create a safe and non-judgmental space within our communities where individuals feel comfortable expressing their questions or concerns about faith?
- Who needs to hear your story? Your faith is meant to be personal but not private. Who needs to hear your story? Who in your life would benefit from your life?
