

# The Good King

Psa 145:6-9 (TPT) Your awe-inspiring acts of power have everyone talking! I'm telling people everywhere about your excellent greatness! [7] Our hearts bubble over as we celebrate the fame of your marvelous beauty, bringing bliss to our hearts. We shout with ecstatic joy over your breakthrough for us. [8] You're kind and tenderhearted to those who don't deserve it and very patient with people who fail you. Your love is like a flooding river overflowing its banks with kindness. [9] God, everyone sees your goodness, for your tender love is blended into everything you do.

Psa 145:11 (TPT) They will tell the world of the lavish splendor of your kingdom and preach about your limitless power.

Psa 145:16-18 (TPT) When you open your generous hand, it's full of blessings, satisfying the longings of every living thing. [17] You are fair and righteous in everything you do, and your love is wrapped into all your works. [18] You draw near to those who call out to you, listening closely, especially when their hearts are true.

## God is good to all

Its impossible to overemphasis the goodness of God.

Rom 2:4 (KJV) Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?

From time to time the enemy will accuse each of us of not being good enough.

Not being worthy of receiving whatever it is we are praying for

And you know what I stopped arguing that point and I agree - I ain't good enough.

I wasn't good enough before I got saved and I ain't been good enough since I've been saved.

But it isn't about my goodness its about God's goodness.

- **The riches of His goodness**
- **Goodness of God that leads**

The enemy would love for us to focus on our goodness

Cause if we feel we are good enough that will certainly end in pride which comes before a fall

If we feel we aren't good enough that ends in condemnation and a shrinking back and God has no pleasure in those who shrink back

But if I focus on HIM - I consider HIS goodness then everything changes.

Now when I am believing God for a breakthrough miracle its not a question of "why would God do this for me?" The question becomes, "Why wouldn't God do this for me?"

His good deeds are not based on my goodness, or your goodness but on His goodness.

**Psa 119:68 (NASB) You are good and You do good; Teach me Your statutes.**

**Psa 119:68 (TPT) Everything you do is beautiful, flowing from your goodness; teach me the power of your wonderful words!**

Its not even a question of how great our faith is. Jesus said something about a mustard seed.

**Mat 17:20 (NASB) ... truly I say to you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you."**

So the issue then is not the greatness of my faith but the greatness of the God in whom I place my faith.

**"Your problem is not the size of your problem your problem is the size of your God."**

When we realize that God is good we are ready for our miracle

One of my favorite Bible personalities is David.

I like David cause he kept it real, and he let me know I can make it.

Over and over again David the Psalmist used the word “Good” when talking about God.

But he did not use the word Good about himself.

He said, I was born in inequity and apart from You I have no good.

But David knew that God was good.

Psa 21:3 (NAS95) For You meet him with the blessings of good things; You set a crown of fine gold on his head.

Tob - health, happiness, wealth, beautiful & better

Blessed all around.

David would say it this way, “apart from the Lord I have no health, no happiness, no wealth, no beauty and will never do better”

But when HIS goodness meets my condition, when HIS goodness invades my circumstances I become healthy, I become happy, I become wealthy and my life becomes beautify. Its just better because God is good.

Moses prayed for God to show him HIS glory and God responded by saying I will show you MY goodness.

The Goodness of God is the Glory of God and the Manifested Glory is Manifested Goodness.

When good things happen for you that is the Glory of God in your life and when you do good for others you are showing them the Glory of God.

Psa 34:8 (NAS95) O taste and see that the LORD is good; How blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him!

Psa 34:10 (NAS95) The young lions do lack and suffer hunger; But they who seek the LORD shall not be in want of any good thing.

Psa 86:5 (NAS95) For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You.

# God is gonna do something good for you today.

When this becomes our reality

That our God is a Good King

We will wake up in the morning and say, before we say anything else,  
Something Good is going to happen to me today!

If you struggle saying that its because your faith is influenced by your history and not HIS personality.

But by faith you say it so that you can see it.

When your faith is based on HIS Word - the Revelation of who HE is you can say ....

Because HE is good and HE does good.

Psa 31:19 (NAS95) How great is Your goodness, Which You have stored up for those who fear You, Which You have wrought for those who take refuge in You, Before the sons of men!

Psa 31:19 (TPT) Lord, how wonderful you are! You have stored up so many good things for us, like a treasure chest heaped up and spilling over with blessings—all for those who honor and worship you! Everybody knows what you can do for those who turn and hide themselves in you.

# Every Divine Declaration is a Divine invitation.

When God declares something of himself it is so you and I can enter into that and receive from Him.

Most theologians agree that there are 7 Redemptive names of God

**JEHOVAH JIREH – THE LORD MY PROVIDER**

**JEHOVAH RAPHA – THE LORD MY HEALER**

**JEHOVAH SHALOM - THE LORD MY PEACE**

God never declares something about Himself for Himself

He declares so we can know it, have faith for it, receive it.

When I need provision I need to know that He is JIREH - the provider, so HE can be MY Provider

When I need healing I need to know that He is RAPHA - the healer so He can be MY healer.

God can never be to you what you won't believe He is.

If someone will not believe that God is Savior guess what He can't be for them?

If you wan't be believe that God is good guess what you will never see?

**Heb 11:6 (ESV) And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.**

According to James 1 if we doubt we have no right to expect for we have no foundation of expectation.

If we wanna see good, to experience good we must believe that HE is good.

You will never possess what you are unwilling to believe.
