Rom 6:4 (AMPC) We were buried therefore with Him by the baptism into death, so that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious [power] of the Father, so we too might [habitually] live and behave in **newness of life.**

The newness of life is literally a new life.

BIOLOGY OF CHRISTIANITY

The biological world is split into six kingdoms

2 of which you are familiar. Kingdom of Animalia Kingdom of Plantea

These kingdoms are used to classify life forms. Each kingdom is comprised of like life forms. The manner of life flowing through the host determines which kingdom it is a part of.

But in all this diversity there is one commonality – the life of the animal. Every animal has the same type of life.

Plants live by different laws than animals and animals have abilities plants don't share.

Now here is an amazing fact we need to know in order to appreciate. THE KINGDOMS ALLOW FOR NO CROSSING OF BORDERS.

Between the kingdoms none of the six may mix

Natural law prohibits the inhabitants of one kingdom from EVER becoming the inhabitants of another kingdom.

In other words no plant can ever uproot and join the animal kingdom.

If you work hard enough, are artistic enough and dedicated enough you can shape a shrub to look like a giraffe – but just because it looks like a giraffe doesn't gain it access into the animal kingdom. It's not based on shape its based on type of life.

Law prohibits kingdom transference.

Natural law is a byproduct of divine law

God declared that every kind would produce after its own kind.

Joh 3:5-6 (NLT) Jesus replied, "I assure you, no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit. [6] Humans can reproduce only human life, but the Holy Spirit gives birth to spiritual life.

Eze 36:26 (NLT) And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart.

- · The new life has new possibilities and abilities
- · This new life has new guidelines and instructions

Eph 4:22-32 (NASB) 22 that, in reference to your former way of life, you are to **rid yourselves of the old self**, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit,

23 and that you are to be renewed in the spirit of your minds,

24 and to **put on the new self**, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

- What do we do with the old rid ourselves of it
- What do we do with the new put it on.

That's a choice.

25 Therefore, ridding yourselves of falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH EACH ONE OF YOU WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, because we are parts of one another.

26 BE ANGRY, AND YET DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger,

27 and do not give the devil an opportunity.

28 The one who steals must no longer steal; but rather he must labor, producing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have something to share with the one who has need.

29 Let no unwholesome word come out of your mouth, but if there is any good word for edification according to the need of the moment, say that, so that it will give grace to those who hear.

30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

31 All bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and slander must be removed from you, along with all malice.

32 Be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

2Co 5:17 (NLT) This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

Gal 6:15 (NASB) For neither is circumcision anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.
