◆ AFFIRMATION OF FAITH *(written by The Reverend Jonathan Murray)*

We believe in God, whose love shaped creation and whose searching questions — “What have you done?” and “Do you also wish to go away?” — are not words of condemnation, but invitations into truth and grace.
