



The Attributes of God - The Uniqueness of God
Questions based on the Attributes of God, A.W. Pink.

1. Before everything else
Genesis 1:1 reads "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."

[Note: The word for God here is plural - Elohim]

What does this tell us about God before he created the heavens and the earth?

2. Why did God create the heavens and the earth?
Ephesians 1:5 reads "He predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with His pleasure and will"

[Note: Predestinate means to determine for a specific destiny, in this case His people as sons and daughters into God's family.]

3. Does God gain anything from us existing, or from our worship or obedience? Why is this?
Job 41:11 reads: "Who has a claim against me that I must pay? Everything under heaven belongs to me."

4. Have you learned anything new about who God is from these Scriptures?

5. Read Exodus 20:4-6 with your parents, this is the second commandment of the ten commandments. Why is it important that we listen to God when He tells us what He is like?
