Kingdom 932---basilela—Royal, Reign, kingdom, product of the King.

I. Declared Kingdom

Daniel 2: 44

Daniel 4: 3

Matt. 3: 2 In those days John the Baptist preaching in the wilderness of Judea. And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Kingdom –932—Royal Dominion!

Matt. 4: 17 "The people which sat in darkness saw great light, and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up. From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Matt.4: 23 "And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

Matt. 5: 3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

Matt. 6: 10 Thy kingdom come, thy will be done...

- II. Distinct Kingdom—Repentance driven—Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.
- III. Desired Kingdom Matt. 6: 10 Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven... Heavenly Kingdom
- IV. Everlasting Kingdom-- 2nd Peter 1: 11 "said that it is the Everlasting Kingdom "And so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."

V. Supernatural Kingdom

Matthew 16: 19 And I will give to you the keys to the kingdom of heaven and whatsoever ye shall bind (1210—fasten, or tie) on earth it shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed (3089—untie) in heaven. Church and Kingdom tied together!

John 3: 3 "Jesus answered and said unto him, verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

John 3: 5 Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except and man be born of water and of the spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God."

Paul calls it the Kingdom of Glory as he writes to the Thessalonian Church 2: 12/ the Kingdom of God in Galatians 5: 21/ The Kingdom of Christ to the church at Ephesus and the Kingdom of his dear Son in Col. 1

Matt. References the kingdom 55 times, Mark 15, Luke 33, and John 36.

Jesus called it the kingdom of the Mystery in Matt: 13, and He tries to explain it with the parable of the Sower, The Parable of the wheat and the tares, the Parable of the Mustard seed, Leaven

VI. The Clock of the Kingdom

He tells us that when the kingdom has been preached in every nation in the world, then would the end come! Matt. 24: 14

VIII. The Warning of the Kingdom

Matt. 21: 43 A He tells the story of the wicked Farmer as the master trusted him with his farm and he went away and when he returned they killed the owner's son desiring to steal the inheritance and he said that "The kingdom of God shall be taken from them and given to a nation bringing forth fruits thereof.
