6. Nails pierced His hands & feet. (Luke 23:33)
7. Sword pierced His side. (John 19:34)

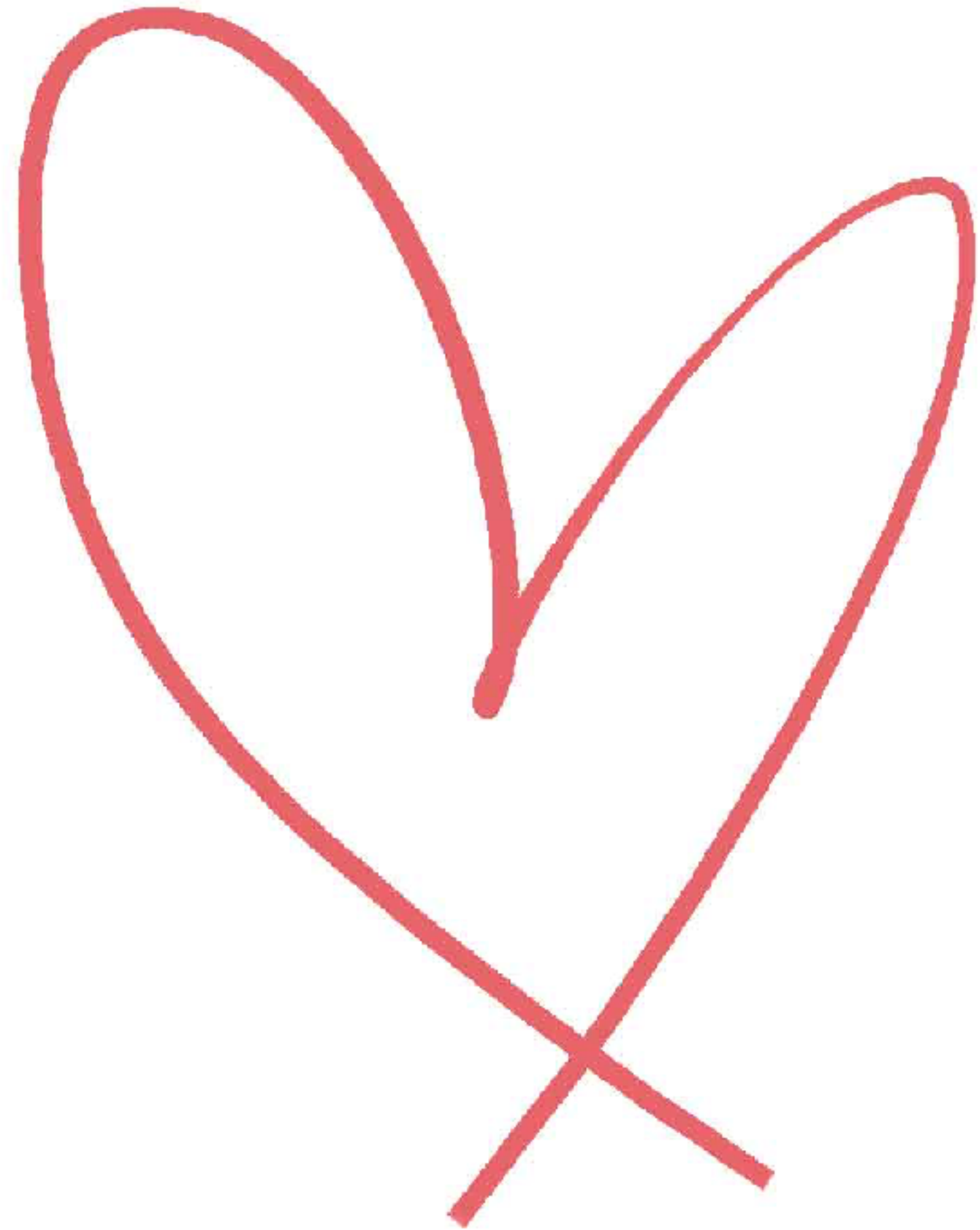
