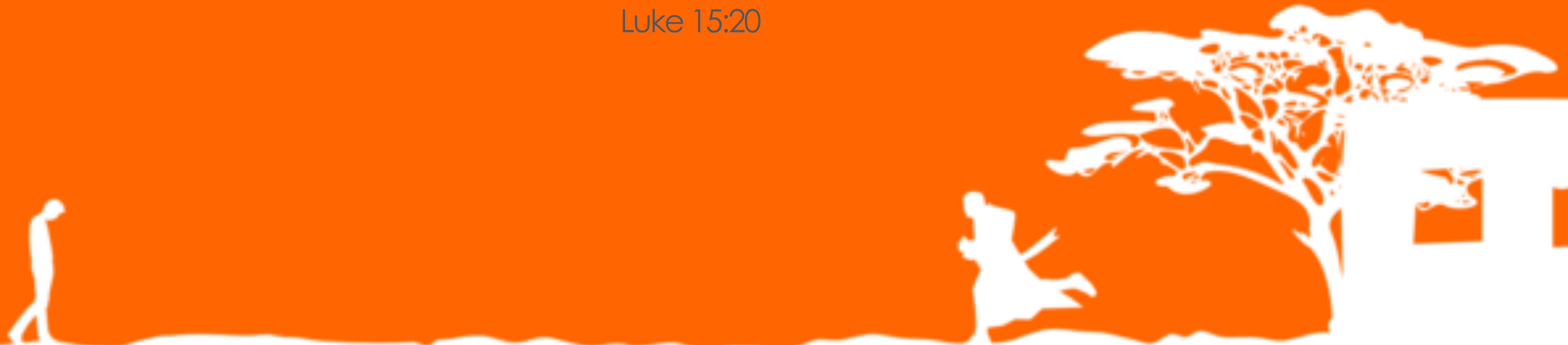


# RUN.

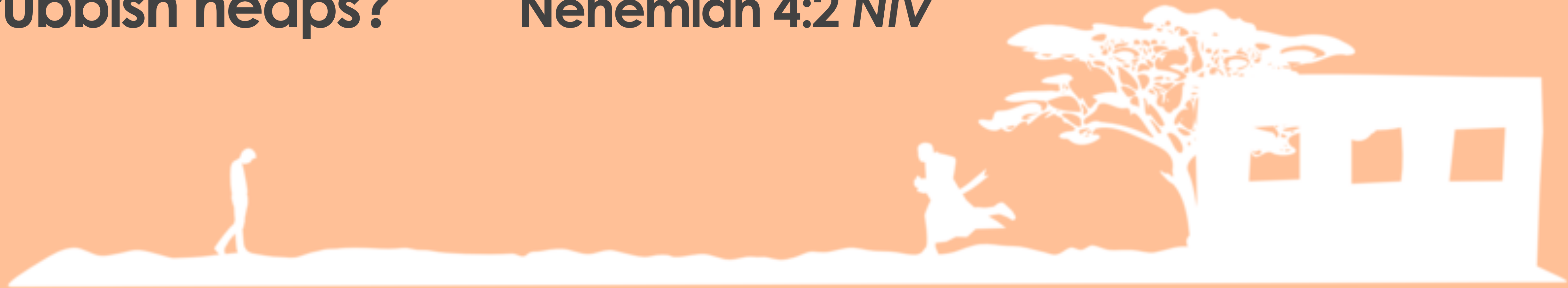
